Saul's name was changed to Paul.	
As part of his preaching Paul wrote many letters (epistles) to early Christian churches.	
Paul wrote these letters as he was unable to visit any churches.	
Paul only preached to the Jews.	
It was Paul's responsibility to preach the good news to the Gentiles.	
Paul taught the people that Jesus would come to earth a second time.	
Paul told the people the date Jesus would return.	
Paul taught about the resurrection of the just and the unjust.	
Paul did not teach anything about a fiery hell to torment unbelievers.	
Paul suffered beatings, shipwreck and imprisonment in his mission to bring the gospel to the people.
