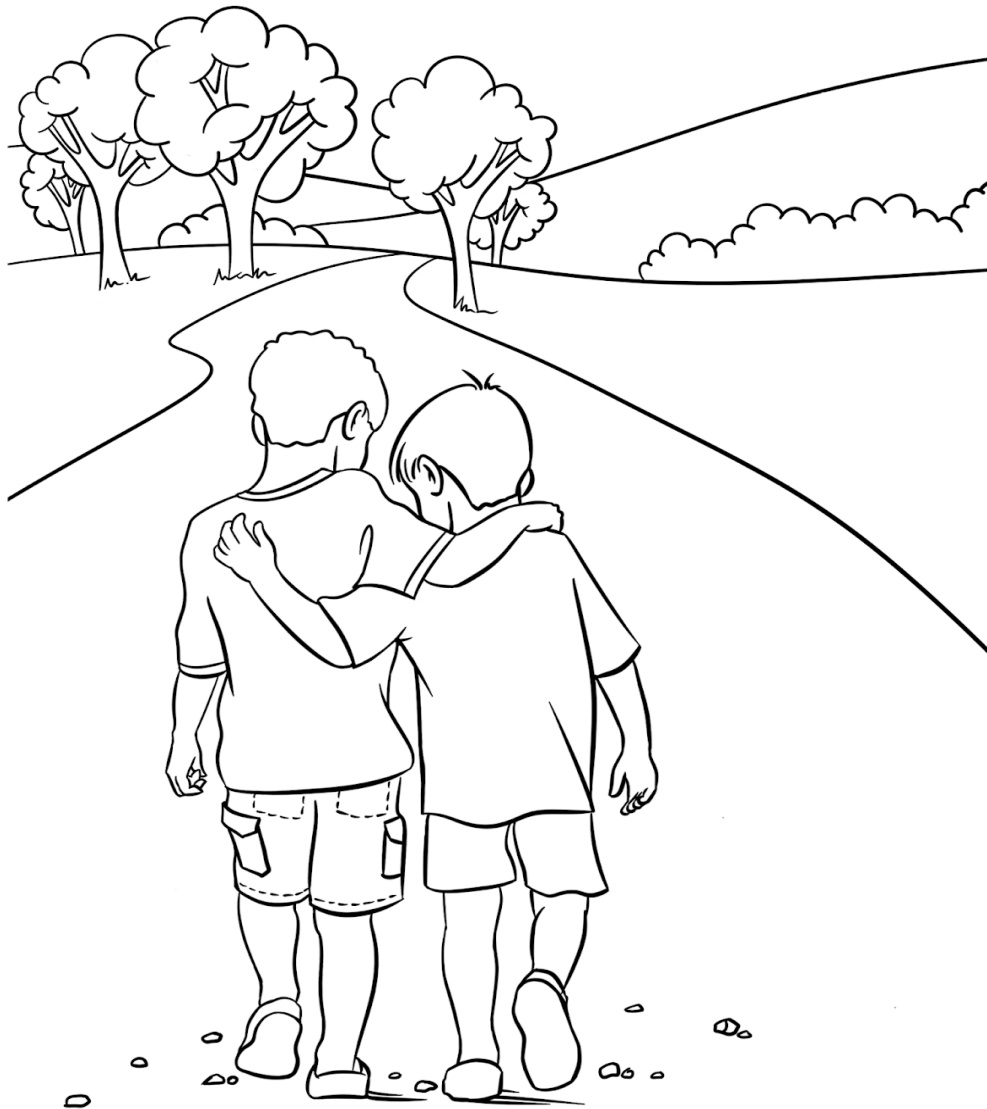

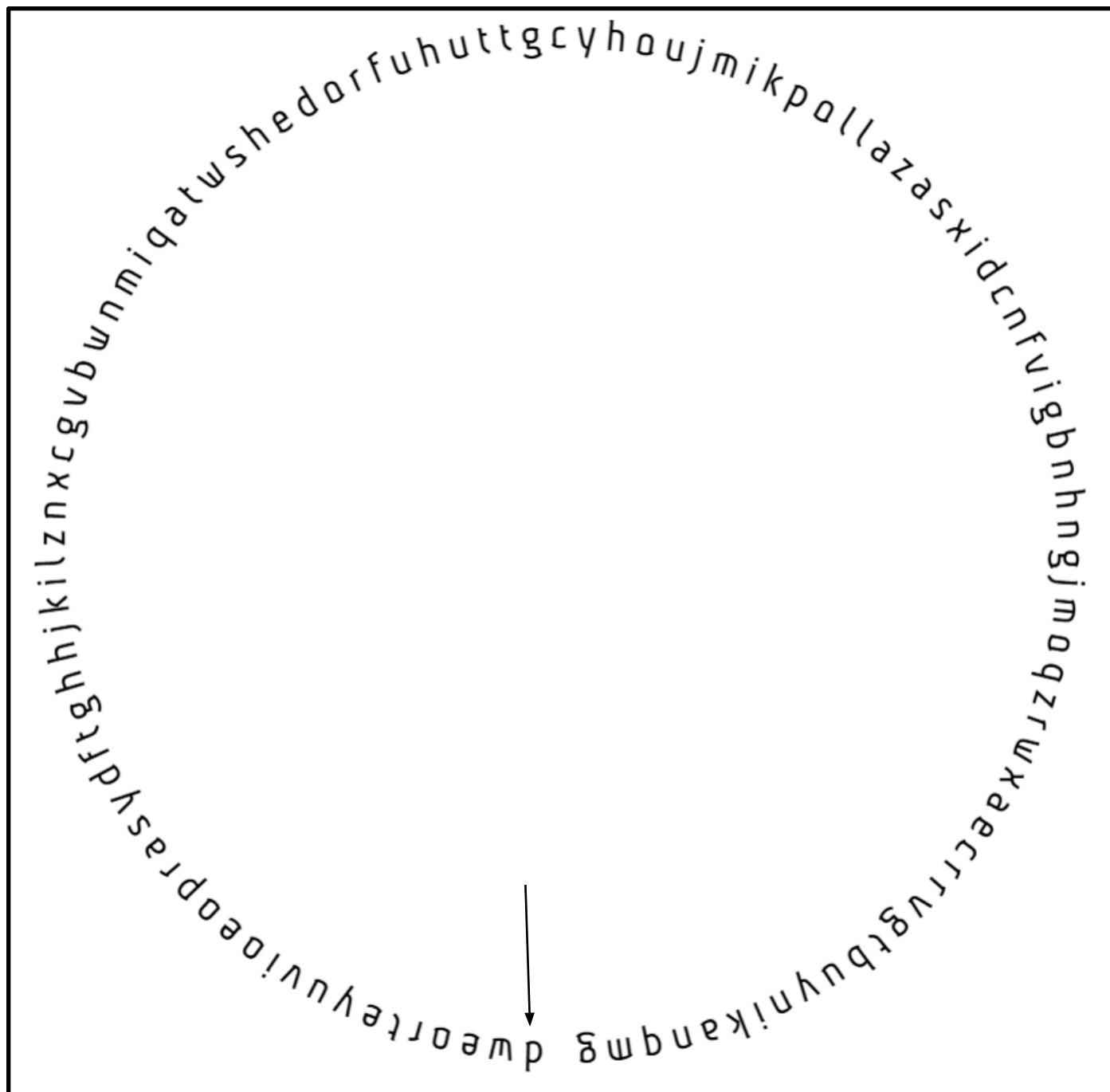
*God doth hate him "that soweth discord (disagreement) among brethren."
