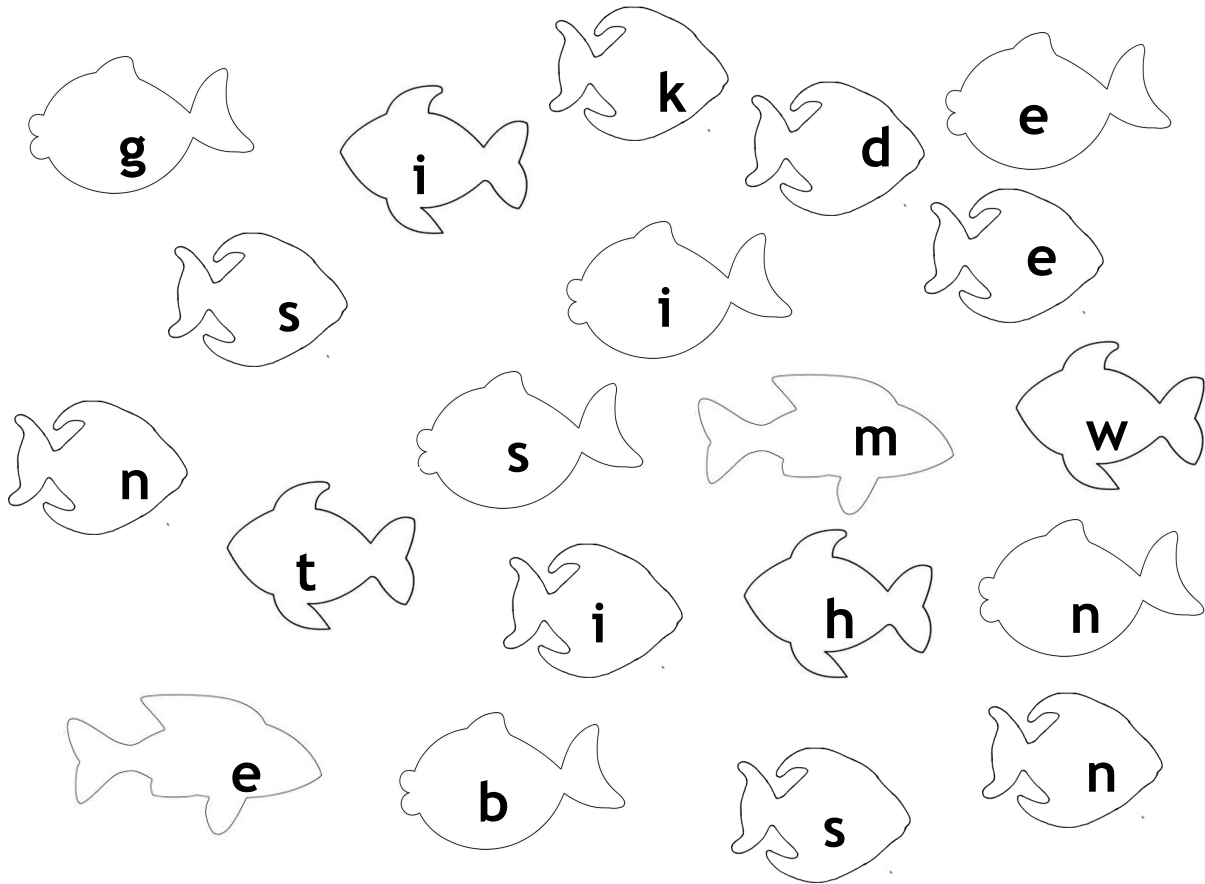
Speak evil of no man. (Titus 3:2)

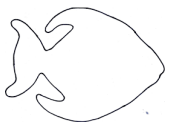


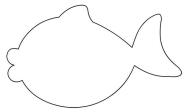
Collect the letters on the same type of fish and then unscramble the letters to read the message.

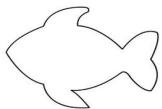


Lettered collected
