

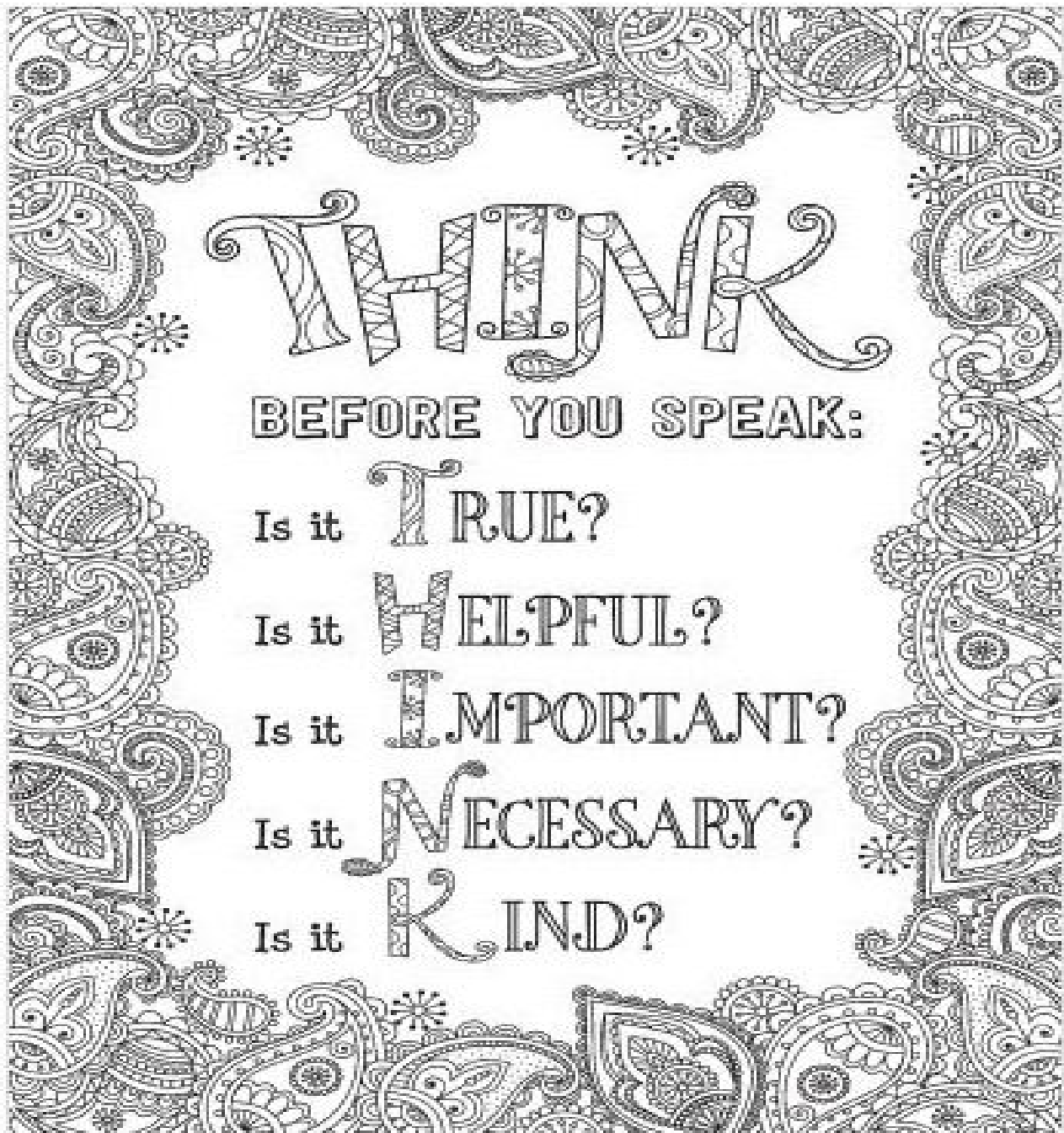

A fool utters (or tells) all his mind: but a wise man keeps it in till afterwards.

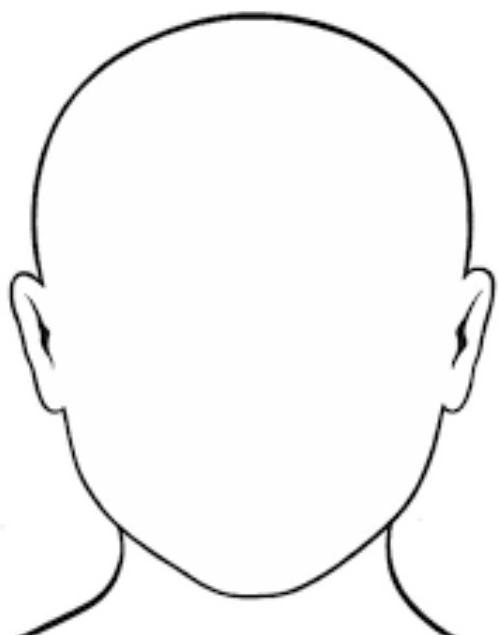
Proverbs 29:11

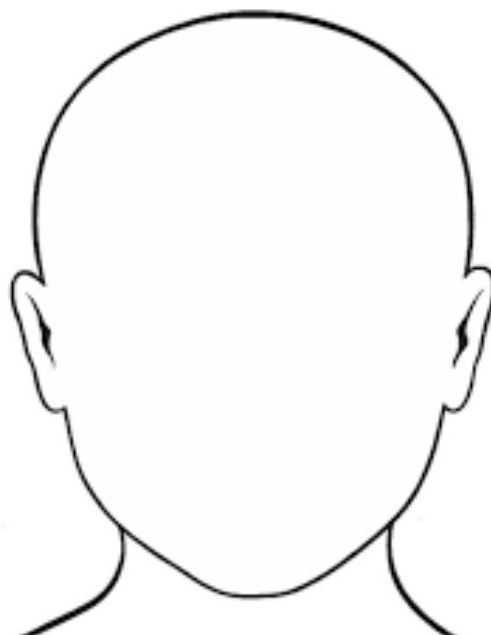
Color the picture



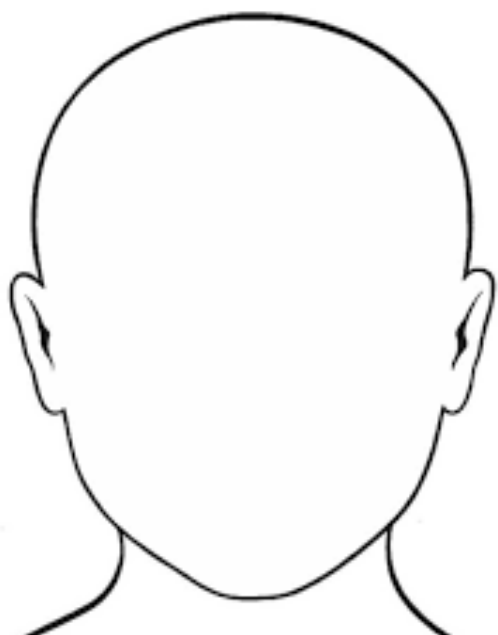

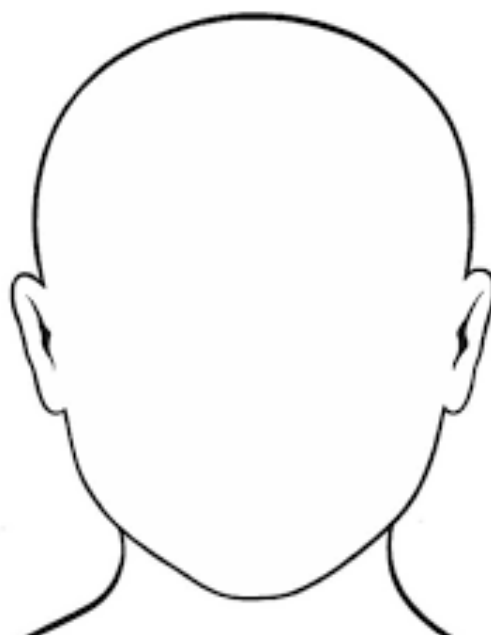
