

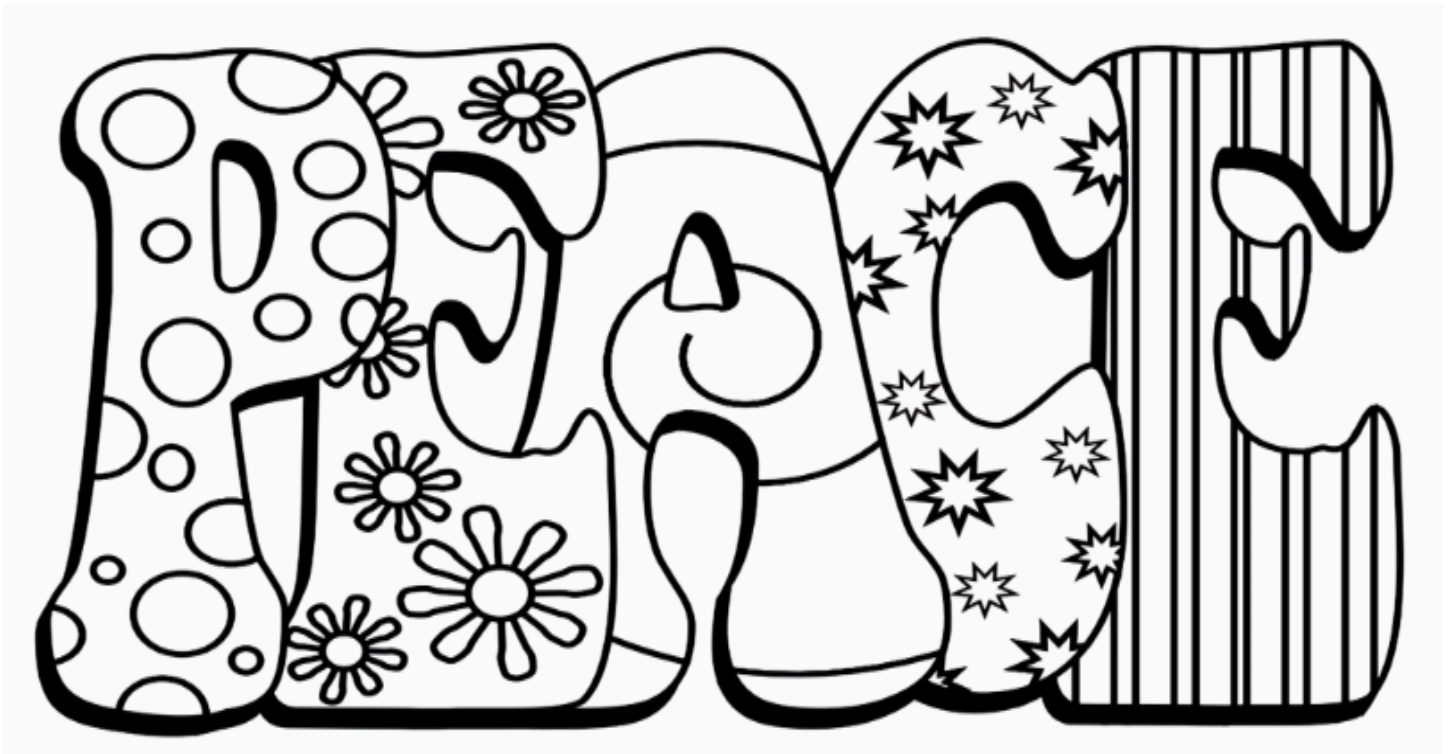

Write an acrostic poem using the word PEACE.

An acrostic poem is a poem where the first letters of each line spell out a word, phrase, or name. The word or phrase is usually the theme or message of the poem.

How to write an acrostic poem:

- Choose a word or phrase to write about
- List the letters of the word or phrase down the side of a page
- For each letter, think of a word, phrase, or sentence that starts with that letter and describes your subject

Features of acrostic poems:

- The words don't have to rhyme, but they can
- The lines of the poem can be any length
- The letters can be placed anywhere on the line, not just at the beginning
