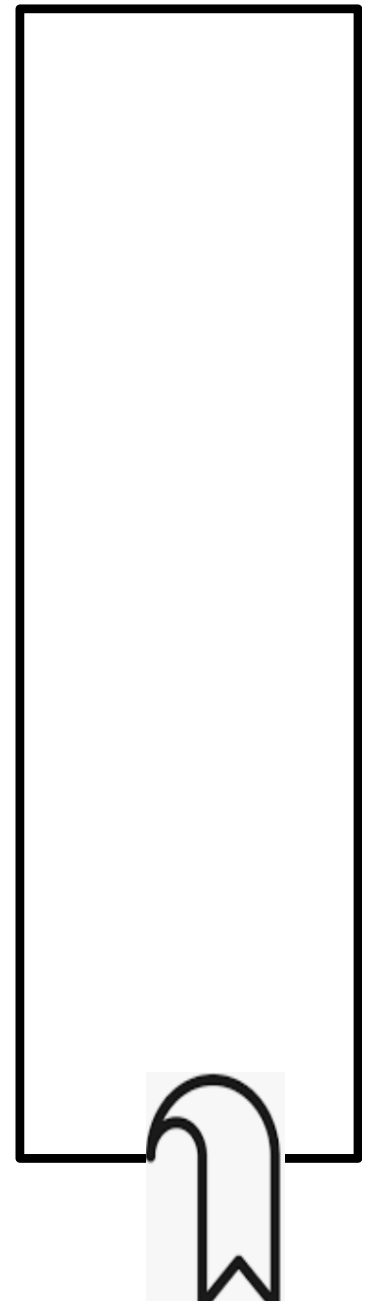
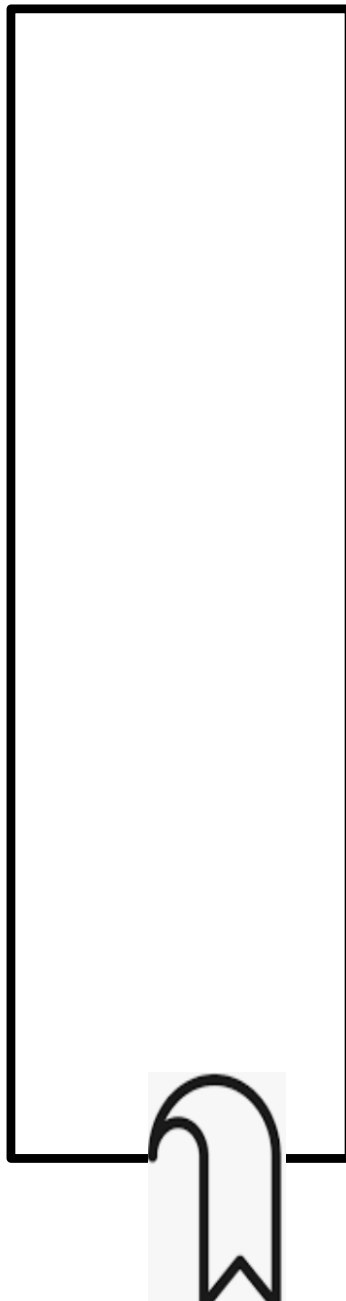
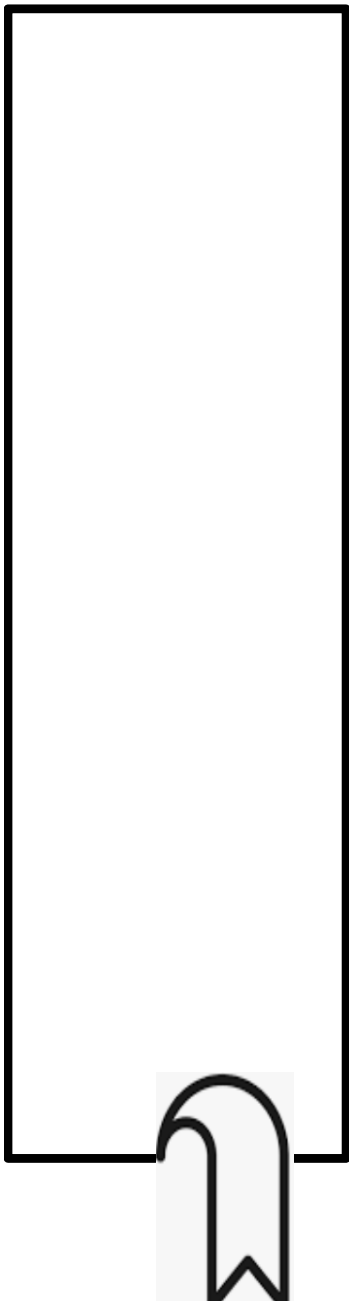
Design a bookmark using the rectangles below which includes a path to follow.
