*Enter ye in at the strait (narrow) gate for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction. (Matthew 7:13)*

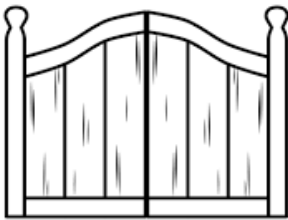
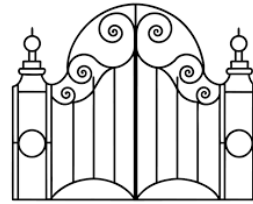
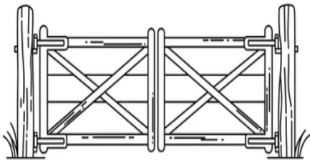
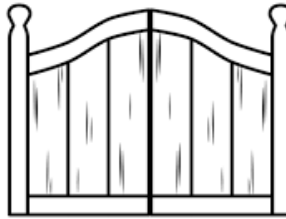
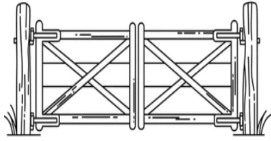
