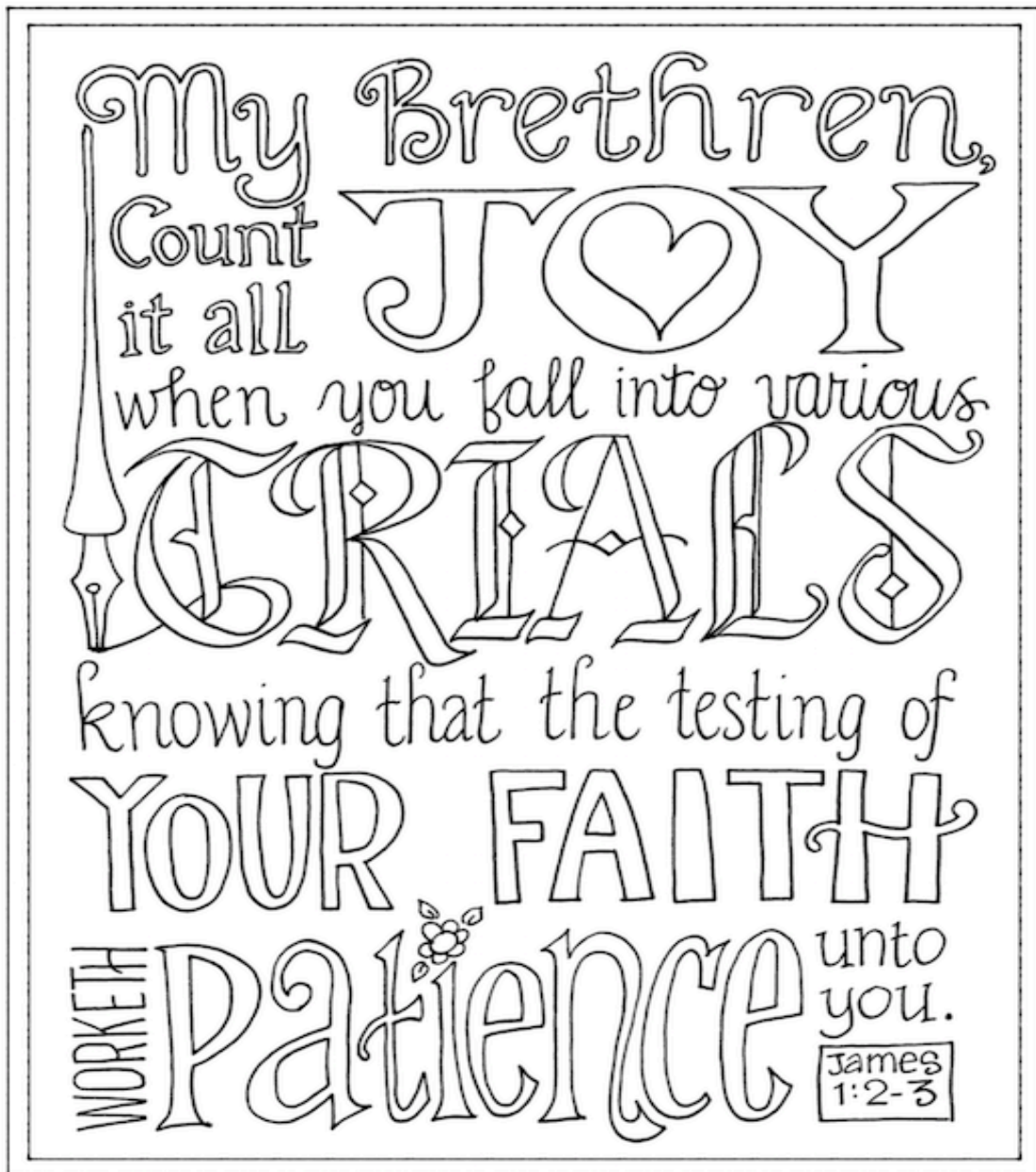

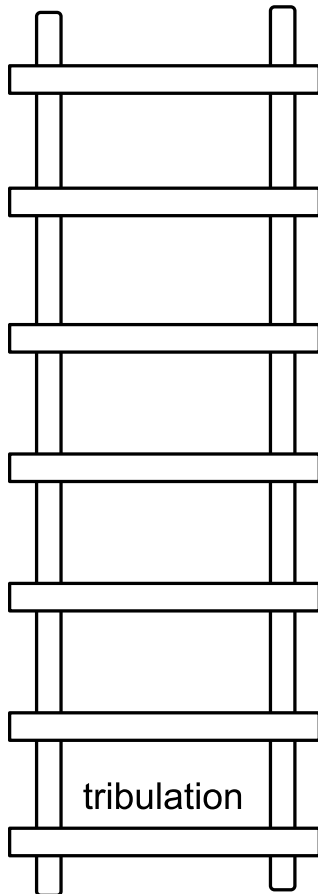
We glory in tribulations also, knowing that tribulation worketh patience. (Romans 5:3)
