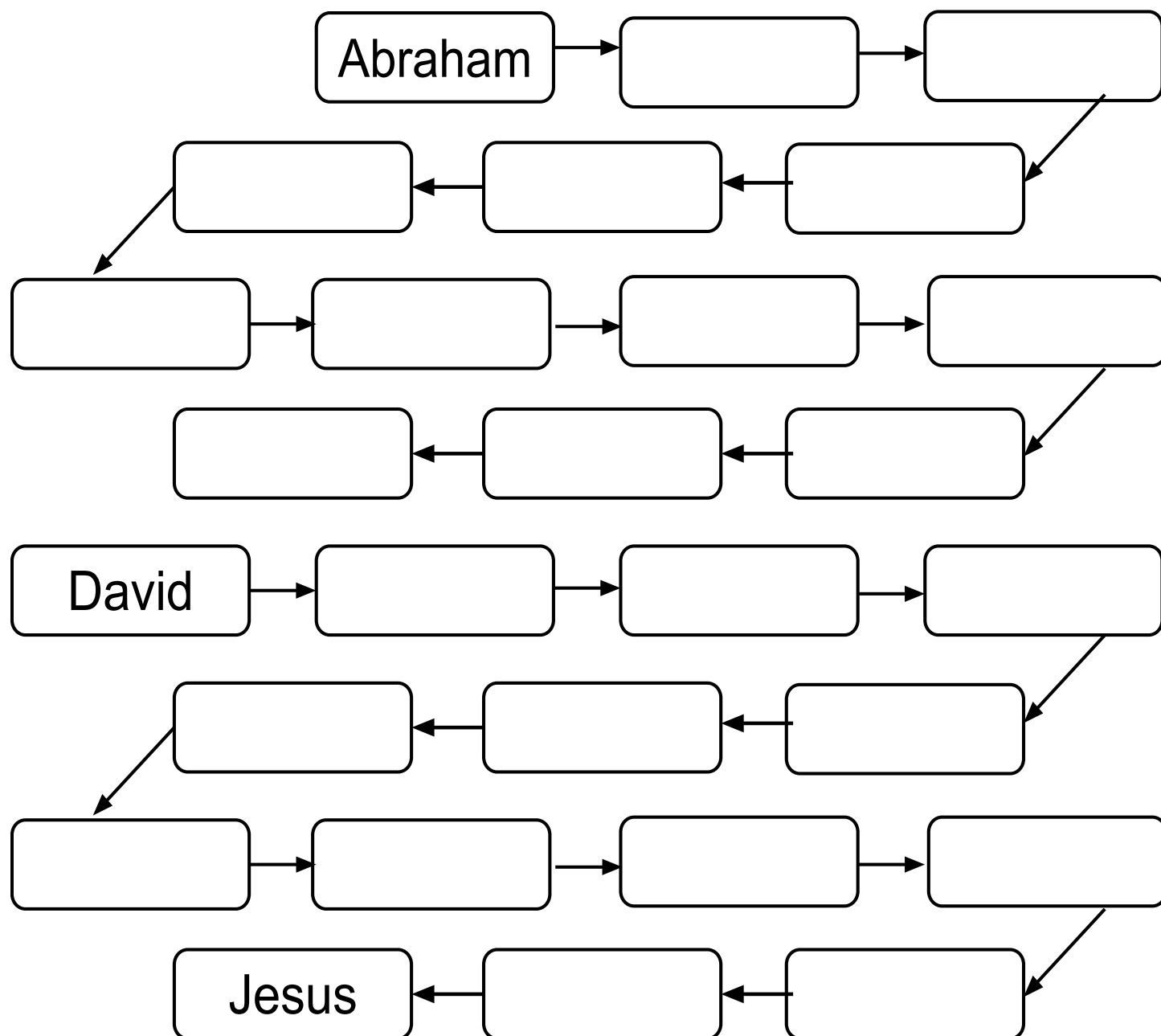
Whither thou goest, I will go. (Ruth 1:16)
