	Produces powerful electric shocks for hunting and defense.
	Has a long spiral tusk that is actually an extended tooth.
	Has three hearts, blue blood, and can squeeze through tiny openings.
	Drums on trees thousands of times a day without damaging its brain.
	Can survive long periods without water and stores fat in its hump.
	Shoots jets of water to knock insects off branches into the water.
	Can run across the surface of water for short distances.
	Has a star-shaped nose with thousands of touch receptors for finding food.
	Snaps its claw to create a powerful shock wave that stuns prey.
