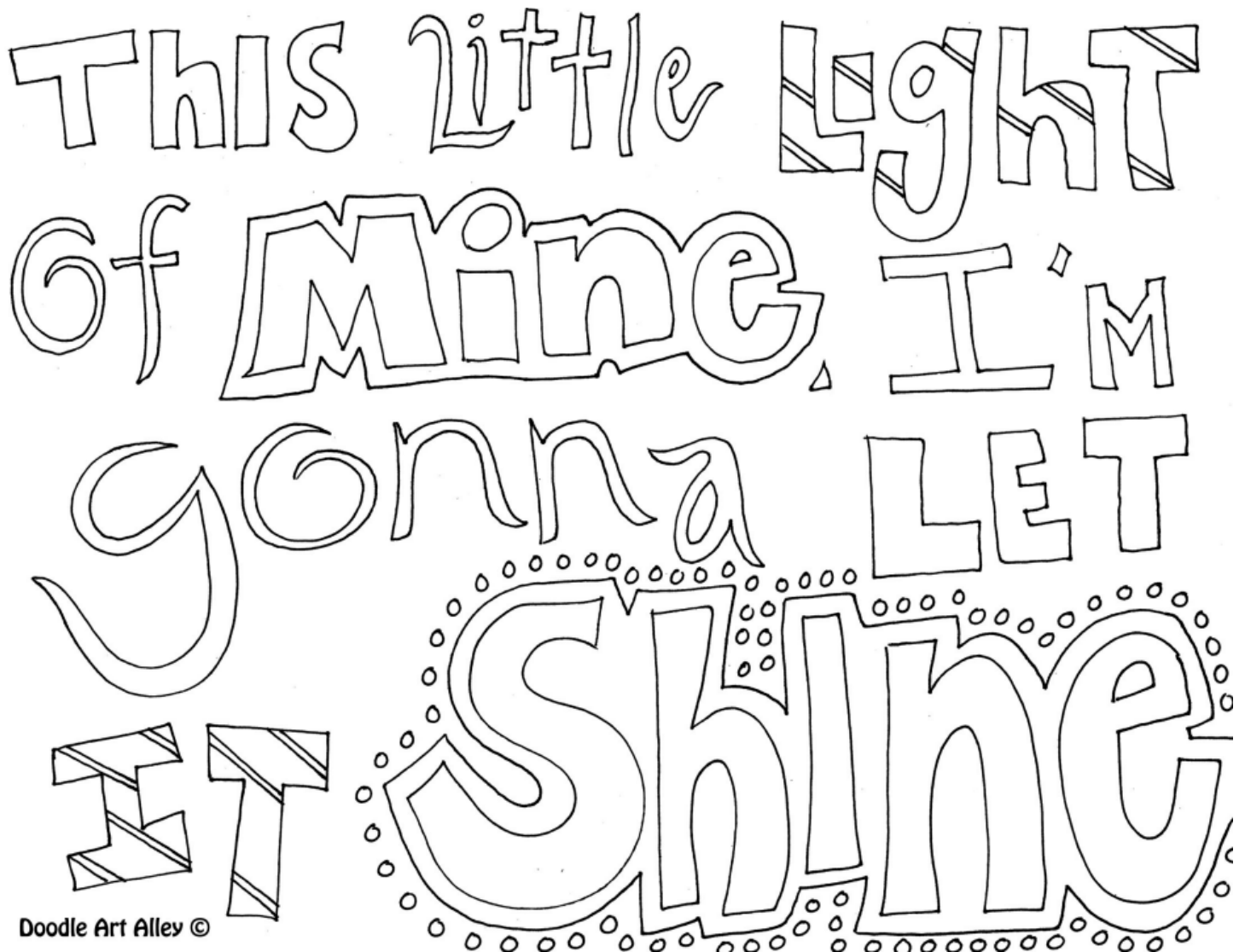

|-----------|--------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
|           | Jesus taught that anyone who wants to follow Him must deny himself, take up his cross daily, and follow Him. |
|           | Joshua instructed Israel to put away false gods and serve the LORD sincerely and faithfully.                 |
|           | Israel was commanded to fear and serve the LORD and not follow other gods.                                   |
|           | Jesus taught that no one can serve two masters; our loyalty cannot be divided.                               |
|           | God's people are told to fear, serve, and hold fast to Him.                                                  |
|           | Jesus said, "Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve."                            |
|           | Samuel told Israel to put away strange gods, prepare their hearts for the LORD, and serve Him only.          |
|           | Joshua declared, "As for me and my house, we will serve the LORD."                                           |
|           | "Thou shalt have no other gods before me." God requires our first and highest loyalty.                       |
|           | Elijah challenged Israel to choose: If the LORD is God, follow Him.                                          |
