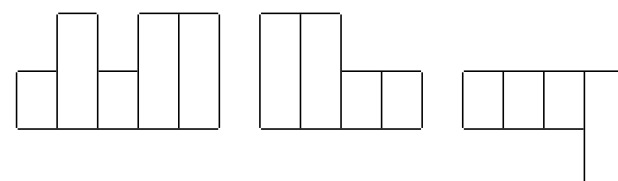
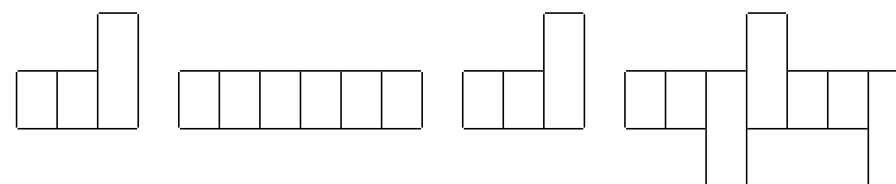
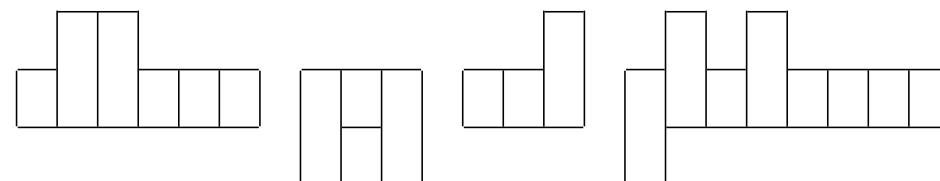
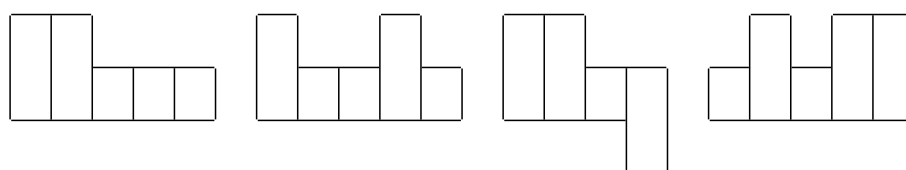
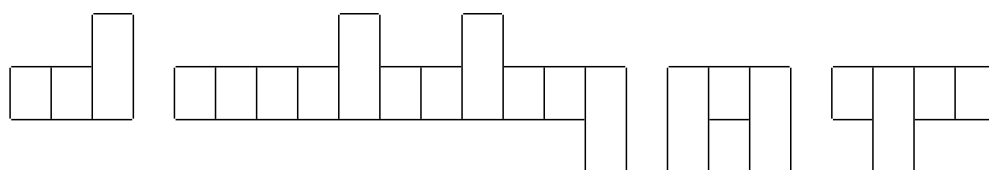
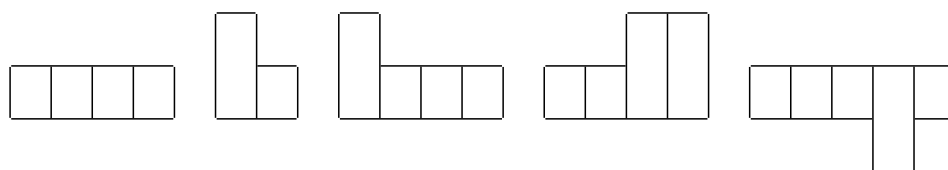
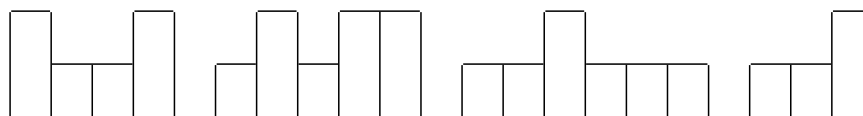
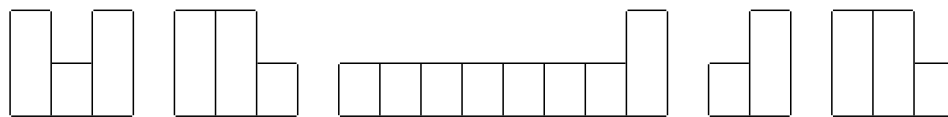
*They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain. (Isaiah 11:9)*
