John 14:26 ERV — *The Holy Spirit teaches us and helps us remember Jesus' words.*

"But the Helper will teach you everything and cause you to remember all that I told you. This Helper is the Holy Spirit that the Father will send in my name."

John 16:13 ERV — *The Spirit guides believers into truth.*

"But when the Spirit of truth comes, he will lead you into all truth. He will not speak his own words. He will speak only what he hears and will tell you what will happen in the future."

Acts 1:8 ERV — *The Holy Spirit gives power to be witnesses for Jesus.*

"But the Holy Spirit will come on you and give you power. You will be my witnesses. You will tell people everywhere about me—in Jerusalem, in the rest of Judea, in Samaria, and in every part of the world."

Romans 8:14 ERV — *The Spirit leads God's children.*

The true children of God are those who let God's Spirit lead them.

Ephesians 3:16 ERV — *The Spirit strengthens us inwardly.*
