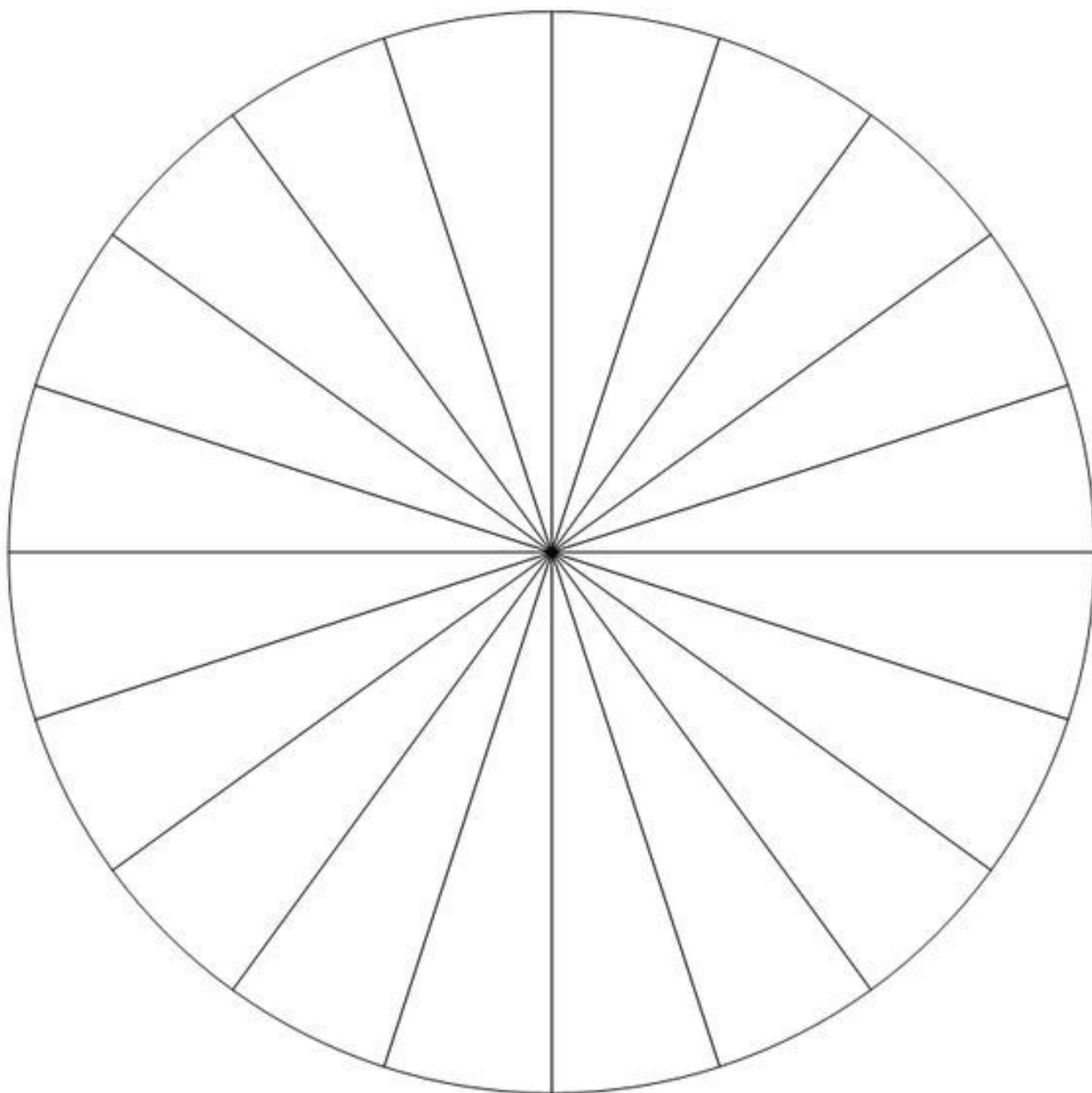
Color the picture
