The Grace of God can reach the unreachable heart and produce a miracle of deliverance.

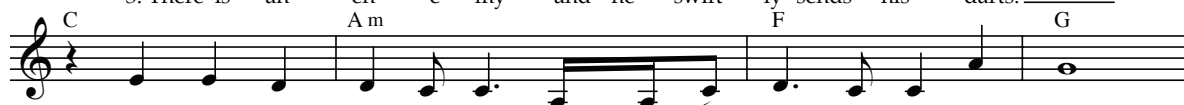
